Bridging the Skills Gap: Preparing Garment Workers for the Digital and Green Economy in Bangladesh and India (Work in progress)

This book chapter is being written as part of the project "Gender Implications of Future of Work in South Asia: The Challenges of Technological Change and Climate Transition in Garment Manufacturing in Bangladesh and India." The chapter examines vocational and skill development needs in the garment sector, with a focus on gender disparities in access to training. The study analyzes how digitalization and climate transition affect women's employment, skill demand, and training accessibility in Bangladesh and proposes gender-responsive policy recommendations to support inclusive workforce transitions. In addition, the analysis extends to the non-RMG manufacturing sector and examines the income effects of vocational training across different worker groups.

Reduction of the Existing Tax Incidence on Renewable Energy Equipment and Its Potential Implications in Bangladesh (Work in progress)

This research paper is being conducted as Component 2 of the project "Sustainable Pathway for Bangladesh's Energy Transformation towards Green and Clean Energy." The study analyzes whether reducing existing VAT, taxes, and duties on renewable energy equipment can accelerate renewable energy adoption in Bangladesh and facilitate a transition away from coal, gas, and LNG-based power generation. It employs cost-benefit analysis and economy-wide Computable General Equilibrium (CGE) modelling to assess short-term fiscal impacts and long-term economic, social, and environmental benefits of tariff reductions.
